## Wine List

At Alléchant, we have carefully selected these wines to accompany our food. They come from different parts of the world, but with an emphasis on the Finger Lakes. Our Finger Lakes, a cool climate wine region, is one of the great wine-producing sites on the planet. Long known for its Rieslings, it produces outstanding sparkling and other white wines as well. Local reds such as Cabernet Franc and Lemberger have also gained international acclaim in recent years.

### SPARKLING

**Dr. Konstantin Frank Brut 2017 (Finger Lakes – Keuka Lake) 14 48**

*Dr. Konstantin Frank has been making sparkling wines since 1985. This méthode champenoise sparkler is composed from a traditional Champagne blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. An elegant bubbly for every occasion.*

### ROSÉ

**Sheldrake Point Dry Rosé 2020 (Finger Lakes – Cayuga Lake) 9 28**

*The perennial favorite rosé of the region. A bright and crisp wine filled with strawberry aromas and flavors. A food-friendly pleaser.*

### WHITES

**Hermann J. Wiemer Dry Riesling 2019 (Finger Lakes – Seneca Lake) 13 39**

*From arguably the best winery in the Finger Lakes, this producer has not missed a beat since Hermann's retirement. His former protégé Fred Merwarth has carried on Hermann's tradition of excellence, exemplified by this outstanding prototypical Finger Lakes Riesling.*

**Wagner Chardonnay Unoaked 2019 (Finger Lakes – Seneca Lake) 9 28**

*Can't stand those oaky Chardonnays? Give this unoaked version from Wagner a try. Without the cloak of woodiness, this versatile wine offers up a pure expression of the grape. Goes well with many foods.*

**Hosmer Sauvignon Blanc 2020 (Finger Lakes – Cayuga Lake) 12 36**

*Hosmer's young and talented winemaker Julia Hoyle has elevated this winery to the top rank in the Finger Lakes. Made from some of the oldest Sauvignon grapes planted in the region, this wine is beautifully balanced and redolent of lime zestiness.*

**João Portugal Ramos Vinho Verde Loureiro 2019 (Portugal) 9 28**

*João Portugal Ramos is considered by many as one of the Portugal's greatest winemakers. The region Vinho Verde literally means green wine in Portuguese. A blend of Loureiro and Alvarinho grapes, this is a refreshing wine with vibrant acidity and green apples accents.*

**Tilia Torrontés 2020 (Argentina) 10 32**

*It is hard for one not to be seduced by the explosive nose of wines made from the Argentinian Torrontés grape. This wine is made from high-altitude grapes and presents a perfect aperitif and palate cleanser between bites.*

### REDS

**Ravines Cabernet Franc 2019 (Finger Lakes – Seneca Lake) 14 48**

*Morten Hallgren has been crafting terrific Cabernet Francs at Ravines for years. This vintage is medium-bodied, with dark berries and herbal undertones. Raised in large casks, it is smooth in texture and perfectly balanced.*

**Borsao Garnacha 2019 (Spain) 9 28**

*Spain has been providing the world with terrific inexpensive red wine for the last decade. And Borsao might well be leading the pack among Spanish red wine values. This Grenache is full-bodied and spicy.*

**Saint Cosme Côtes du Rhône 2020 (France) 12 36**

*While most Côtes du Rhône utilize Grenache as its primary grape, St. Cosme's CdR is 100% Syrah. A warm and full-bodied wine with whiffs of herbs de Provence, it is great with beef and poultry dishes.*

**Root: 1 Pinot Noir 2018 (Chile) 10 30**

*A lovely and pure Pinot Noir fermented in stainless steel. The proximity of the vineyard to the Pacific Ocean keeps temperature cool at night. Smooth and bright. It's the antithesis to the west coast heavy-handed Pinots.*

**Altesino Toscana Rosso 2019 (Italy) 12 36**

*From the heart of Tuscany, this Tuscan red is comprised of 80% Sangiovese and 20% Cabernet/Merlot. The supple mouthfeel, lush berries and smooth tannins make this wine a good match for food from creamy pasta to roasted poultry.*

### DESSERT

**Vietti Moscato d'Asti 2020 (Italy)**

*Slight frizzante, pale yellow with peach and ginger tones 100% Moscato d'asti. 375 ml 16*
